- *Responding to the Next Pandemic: a Simulation Exercise* (Group #1)

A group of approximately 50 students will engage in a role play to respond to a new pandemic hitting the world in September 2026. Students will be divided in group and pre-assigned specific roles. Throughout the exercise, facilitators will provide specific inputs to alter the course of the pandemic and to challenge participants to identify solutions to bring the pandemic to an end in the swiftest way possible.

- *Guided Reflection on the Simulation Exercise.*

At the end of the simulation exercise, students will share their experience from the role play and will be engaged in a discussion on learnings and potential applications in a real life context.
